ments (ie. Discovery, Systematic Instruction, Job Development, and SS Benefits).

Further Clarification on In-House Training approval/certification:

Further clarification was requested about how Service Providers can obtain approval/ certification for their in-house training. Stephanie Roncal, DHS, indicated that ACRE certification would be the avenue. ODDS is not in a position to approve or certify the classes.
