
When things move Quickly!

Someone is doing Job Exploration or Discovery and BANG they are offered a perfect Job for them! Awesome!

Yet, how do you get the VR/OCB/TVR and ODDS Systems to move fast enough to get job coaching in place before the person starts their job?

TIPS

- Refer to VR/OCB/TVR at the beginning of Discovery
- Contact VR/OCB/TVR as soon there is a job offer and requested expedited processing (even if they are not open yet)



Most importantly assist the person to ACCEPT THE JOB!

 Ask the Service Coordinator/Personal Agent to emailAcacia.McGuireAnderson@state.or.us or Alli son.Enriquez@state.or.us to request an exception for time-limited job coaching while the person goes through the VR process
